Eagle Ridge Academy Teachers Strive for Excellence

Our staff is committed to developing a culture of continuous school improvement and we would like for parents to be aware of our efforts. Each year the entire staff participates in reviewing and revising our school improvement plan. We use available data from test scores, report cards and surveys to identify areas we need to improve. Once areas of concern are identified we develop an action plan of research based best practices. This year we are implementing the Cornerstone Literacy Framework and have recently undergone a school wide Cornerstone Review. The Review is completed by a team of seven professionals. Two members were with the Cornerstone Group and the other five were educators from other Muscogee County Schools.
