The tri-board should be neat, colorful, and pleasing to the eye.

## **Left Panel:**

### Statement of Problem:

Write brief explanation of the purpose of the project and the problem being investigated.

### Procedures:

How did you conduct your project? What were the steps involved?

### Materials:

List the materials needed / used for your project.

## **Center Panel:**

### Analysis of Findings:

This is basically is a written, shorter summary of your larger report. This is the best place to put charts or other data to represent your findings. The "analysis of findings" should explain your charts, pictures, photos, etc.

## **Right Panel:**

### Conclusion:

What did you find out? What conclusions can you draw from your project?

### Evaluation of Work:

This is basically your personal comments / observations regarding your work. These are personal comments about your project and findings.
